

**ANALYSIS OF 2009 AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES 1, 8 AND 9 OF THE
DELAWARE UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE**

No amendments to Article 1 or Article 8 of the Delaware Uniform Commercial Code, 6 *Del. C.* § 1-101 *et seq.* (the "DUCC"), were enacted in 2009. Amendments to Article 9 of the DUCC were contained in Delaware State Senate Bill No. 26, 77 Del. Laws, c. 31, and in Delaware State House Substitute No. 1 for House Bill No. 267 as amended by House Amendment No. 2, 77 Del. Laws, c. 78, §§ 1-2, 69. The changes became effective August 1, 2009, and were limited to Sections 9-521 and 9-525 of DUCC Article 9. The amendments to Section 9-521 provide an alternative form for a financing statement amendment and the addendum thereto, and the amendments to Section 9-525 adjust fees payable to the Delaware Secretary of State for certain filings and services.
